

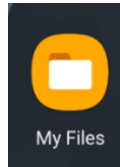
1. Browse to <https://fwcert.hillbrook.qld.edu.au>

3. Click the  button.

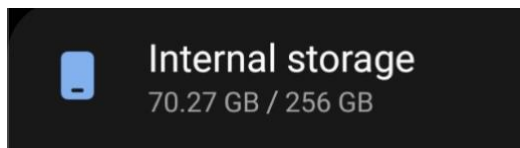
4. Close your browser on your device.

5. Open the "Files" app on your device.



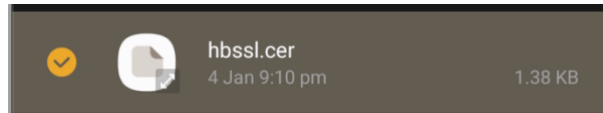


6. Scroll down and select "Internal storage".

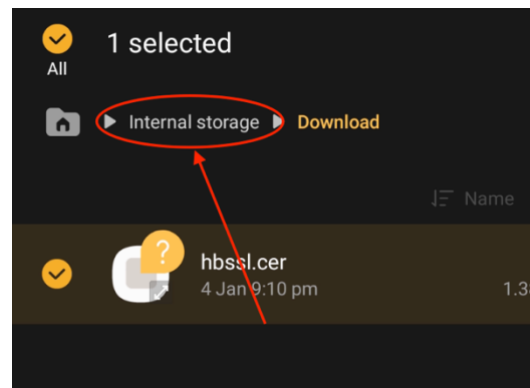


7. Select the "Downloads" folder.

9. Select  from the bottom of the screen.



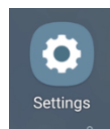
10. Navigate back to "Internal storage".

11. Select "Move here" at the bottom of the screen. The hbssl.cer file should appear in the window.

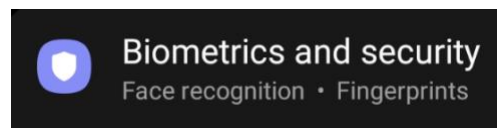


12. Close the "Files" app.

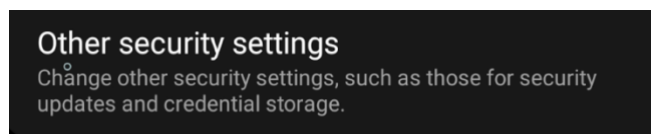
13. Open "Settings".



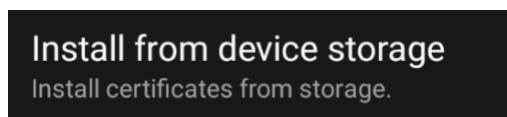
14. Scroll down and select "Biometrics and security".



15. Scroll down and select "Other security settings".

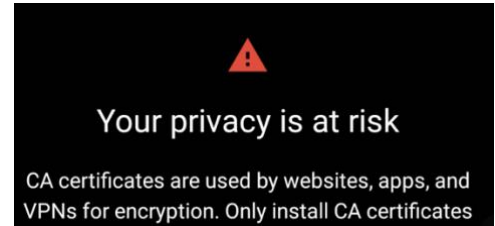
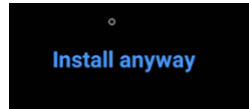


16. Select "Install from device storage".



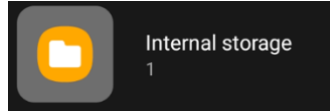
17. Select "CA Certificate".

18. Your device will display a privacy warning. Select "Install anyway".

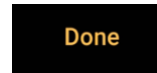
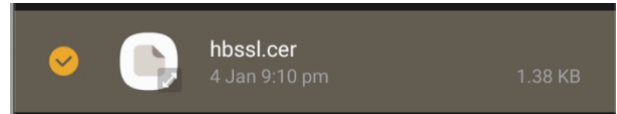


19. Your device will ask for your PIN or to scan your fingerprint.
